2019 MEMBERSHIP REGISTRATION INFORMATION

SAGF BASIC TERMS and CONDITIONS of REGISTRATION

The person responsible for registering individuals or entering individuals for events on their behalf is also responsible for informing those individuals, including parents and guardians, in the case where the individual is a minor, of the below terms and conditions.

CLUBS AND INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS:

1. I hereby declare that I am aware of no reason why I should not be granted the requested membership registration.
 - I undertake to immediately return/update my registration in the event of any substantial change to the circumstances existing at the time of the application for membership.
 - I declare that I have not applied for an additional membership for the same year to the SAGF.
 - I assume exclusive liability for this application and for the use that I shall make of the membership.
2. I hereby undertake to respect the constitution and regulations of the SAGF, its provincial and district affiliates and its macro bodies, including SASCOC and FIG.
 - I declare that I have read or have had the opportunity to become acquainted with the aforesaid SAGF constitution and regulations.
 - I shall participate in Gymnastics competitions or events in a sporting and fair manner.
 - I shall submit to disciplinary measures taken against me and shall take any appeals and litigation before the authorities provided for in the regulations.
3. I understand and accept that SAGF will conduct spot checks to verify information.

GYMNASTS:

4. I agree to submit to and be bound by the SAIDS (South African Institute for Drug Free Sport) antidoping regulations, the clauses of the World Antidoping Code and its international Standards to which the SAIDS antidoping regulations refer and to the antidoping regulations of other competent bodies as per the regulations of the World Antidoping Code provided that they comply with that Code.
 - I agree that the results of the analysis may be made public and communicated in detail to my club or team or to my paramedical assistant or doctor.
 - I agree that my doctor or the doctor of my club or team may, on a request from the SAGF, communicate to it a list of any medicines I may take and treatment I may undergo before any given competition.

CATEGORY D REGISTRATIONS BY NUMBER (SCHOOLS AND PRESCHOOLS):

5. I understand, accept and agree that:

- Category D registrations by Number/Group (non-paying members) submitted by me will require the submission of a stamped and signed declaration by the Principal or Head of the School or Pre-school; as well as a list of gymnasts;
- Information entered for Category D registration is true and correct. If any information is falsified or cannot be verified by SAGF, it may subject me to a disciplinary process.

EVENTS:

6. I understand, accept and agree that, should I enter or participate in a SAGF or any of its Provincial/District affiliates event, be it a competition, course or any other activity:

- I recognize the inherent hazards that may exist with participation in sporting events, including Gymnastics events and hereby acknowledge that I will enter these events entirely at my own risk.
- I will commit myself to the prescribed activities, the rules and regulations of the event prescribed by SAGF and its representatives organizing the event. I understand that failure to adhere to the prescribed rules and regulations may affect my successful participation in that event.
- In the absence of a full or partial sponsorships towards my participation, I undertake to cover the required costs of my entry to the event that I will be entered for and undertake to pay the full amount by the stipulated due date.
- I will have no claim that may arise either directly or indirectly of whatsoever nature and whatsoever cause against SAGF/Province/District/Organisers or any of its affiliated bodies or persons, should I suffer any loss/injury as a result of my or the minor's attendance or participation at any SAGF/Provincial/District Event and everything relative thereto, including travelling thereto and back.

INDEMNITY:

7. I hereby declare that by entering gymnasts or officials into any competition, activities or event hosted by SAGF or any of its Provincial/District affiliates, that:

- I have a current, valid and signed indemnity form for every gymnast and official being entered.

2019 MEMBERSHIP REGISTRATION FEES

Below, please find the information pertaining to the 2019 Individual and Institution Membership Fees:

The **closing date** for re-registrations of gymnasts/officials that **have been registered before**, is as follows:

Clubs/Schools/Community Centre:	Monday, 4 March 2019
Gymnasts & Officials:	Monday, 18 March 2019

Please note: each District will be charging the clubs a membership fee. Your district will be in contact with you on this and each district will determine its own fee and managing and administering it themselves. Please note that your club will only be active online once the District and SAGF membership fees have been paid in full.

We would like to bring to your attention that only once your club is active online, can you register gymnasts, coaches or judges. As a result, we strongly recommend that you to register your club long in advance of the March 4, 2019 closing date.

The **closing date for registrations of new competitive members is: Anytime during the year**

Please note: New members that wish to compete, need to be registered and active on the system at least 2 weeks before the entry closing date of their competition. This means that applications to be registered needs to be made 3 weeks before the closing date of the competition to allow sufficient turnaround time for the administration process and for the gymnast to reflect online.

A late registration penalty fee of 50% will be charged by SAGF for **previously registered gymnasts** registering after the above date. Non-competitive members can be registered throughout the year, without penalty. No penalty will be charged for upgrades from Cat D.

Gymnasts or coaches moving clubs need to complete and sign the transfer form, before registering on the system. The transfer form needs to be signed by both clubs and emailed to Megan on megan@wcga.co.za

PLEASE NOTE: Gymnasts can only be registered on the system once.

The Membership cycle runs from 1 January – 31 December and the fees are non-refundable.

Individual Membership Registration Fees

Category A = Competitive = R525.00

Any institution or individual (gymnast or coach) who participates in SAGF competitive structures
SAGF receives R290.00, Province receives R170.00, Club receives R65.00

UPGRADE FROM CATEGORY B TO CATEGORY A = R455

UPGRADE FROM CATEGORY E TO CATEGORY A = R325

WC Clarification: Category A includes a gymnast involved in all competitive levels. If a gymnast is wishing to compete at district, provincial or national events they must be registered in this category. This is a coach who is wishing to go on the floor at district, provincial or national events.

Category B = Non-Competitive = R70.00

Any institution or individual (gymnast or coach) who does not participate in SAGF competitive structures or is only involved in Gym for All discipline.

If a member is a supporter or only a judge, they register as category B.

This category is purely non-competitive and makes no distinction between whether a member comes from an advantaged or disadvantaged background.

SAGF receives R32.00, Province receives R25.00, Club receives R13.00

WC clarification: This is a gymnast participating in Gym for All, Club Awards programs as well as pre-schoolers participating at clubs. This includes supporters and GL coaches. If a member is only a judge, they register as category B.

Category C = Competitive = R70.00

An institution or individual (gymnast or coach) who participates in SAGF competitive structures, and the institution is a NPO, or the individual's family comes from a financially disadvantaged background.

Provinces are requested to put appropriate mechanisms in place to assist in preventing abuse of Category C registration by any of their members in their Province.

SAGF receives R32.00, Province receives R25.00, Club receives R13.00

WC clarification: This is a gymnast who is competitive and classified, by their province, as currently financially disadvantaged. Category C is allocated in exceptional cases of hardship only. The individual does not have to be a previously disadvantaged individual, but rather an individual currently experiencing financial hardship.

PLEASE NOTE: ALL Cat C applications need to be applied for via the WCGA (even if you were registered as Cat C in 2018). The club/member will need to fill in the application form (attached) and send it, along with ALL the supporting documentation in ONE email to Megan at Megan@wcga.co.za

Category C applications closing dates:

Existing Cat C members (members registered in 2018 or earlier): **Wednesday, 27 February 2019**

NEW Category C members (i.e. members not previously registered with SAGF): Application needs to be submitted to Megan at least 5 weeks prior to the closing date of the first competition, to allow for the administrative approval process of District and Province. Applications received after the 5 week cut off will not be considered and will be deemed Cat A.

Category D = School participant = R0

Any institution or individual who takes part in Gymnastics for free (no fees are paid by individuals to coaches for lessons). This also refers to a coach or judge who is an educator that only coaches or judges in a school and at inter-schools league competitions. This mainly refers to schools and community Centres. These are schools involved in the SRSA Schools Sport Programme and community centres that are purely recreational (non-competitive) that do not charge class fees. Only Category D Institutions can register Category D individuals.

Category E = Competitive = R200.00

Any individual who participates in Inter Club Competitions only. Only Category A and C Institutions can register Category E individuals.

SAGF receives R92.00, Province receives R72.00, Club receives R36.00

WC Clarification: Category E includes a gymnast involved in only inter-club competitions. If a gymnast is wishing to compete at interclub competitions, this is the category for their registration.

Life Member = R5220.00

An individual who wishes to be registered with the South African Gymnastics Federation for their lifetime. This is a once off payment and does not have to be repeated again. Life Membership is a Cat A membership.

SAGF receives R2400.00, Province receives R1880.00, Club receives R940.00

Institution Membership Registration Fees

Any Club, School, University, Community Centre or institution registered with their District as a category A, B, C or D institution.

Category A = Competitive Organisation = R1 735.00

Any institution that participates in SAGF competitive structures.

SAGF receives R210.00, Province receives R1525.00

Category B = Non-Competitive Organisation or Institution = R245.00

Any institution that does not participate in SAGF competitive structures or is only involved in Gym for All discipline.

SAGF receives R85.00, Province receives R160.00

Category C = Competitive Organisation = R245.00

An institution that participates in SAGF competitive structures, and the institution is a NPO, or the institution serves mainly gymnasts from a financially disadvantaged background.

Provinces are requested to put appropriate mechanisms in place to assist in preventing abuse of Category C registration by any of their members in their Province.

SAGF receives R85.00, Province receives R160.00

PLEASE NOTE: ALL Cat C CLUB MEMBERSHIPS HAVE TO BE APPLIED FOR VIA WCGA. The club will need to write a motivating letter or submit the NPO Certificate to Megan on Megan@wcga.co.za. Even if you were classified as a Cat C Club in 2018, you will need to reapply.

Category D = School = R0 total

These are schools involved in the SRSA Schools Sport Programme and community centres that are purely recreational (non competitive) that do not charge class fees. Alternatively, any institution that provides Gymnastics for free, and where the individuals pay no fees to the coaches or organisation for lessons.
