# ACROBATICS GYMNASTICS

#### INFORMATION CLUBS/COACHES

Please see general rules for our competition. Please make sure that Coaches/Judges and parents are informed of information. We aim to have a smooth competition.

## **MUSIC**

- All music needs to be one cd per group. NO FLASH DRIVES OR OTHER FORMAT
   OF MUSIC... WILL BE ALLOWED. Please make sure to have it done correct,
   otherwise your group will compete with out music.
- Make sure your music (CD's) are marked clearly. On the Final program on the left side are the number of the group competing, this is the number you use on your disk.
- Make sure your CD's are in the order of the program when giving it in at the competition. All music need to be in at 07h30.
- Make sure of your music's quality and that it is copied correctly on the disk. And that it is working properly.
- If the above is not done, the CJP will take a penalty for music on your group.

## **TARIFF SHEETS**

- Tariff sheets needs to be marked clearly, the number are on the left side of the program for each group.
- Make sure that you have a tariff sheet for all your groups competing.
- Please check your tariff sheet and make sure that all information are correct and clear on the sheet.
- All tariff sheet to be handed in at the scorer before 08h00 on the day of competition.
- Place all tariff sheets in the order of the program before handing it in.
- If the above are not in order, the DV judge will take a penalty on the tariff sheets.

#### **JUDGES**

- All judges must be in the correct dress code. This rule are in the Code of Points.
- Judges must be there at 07h45. If judges are late the club will get a penalty.
- Judges will judges according to the Code of Point rules.
- If the CJP see that there are unfair judges they will be asked to leave the judges panel. As this is a Provincial Team selection competition and marks need to be correct.
- Please make sure that all your judges goes through the Code of Point before the competition, so that they are sure about all the deduction in Artistry or Execution.

#### **PRIZEGIVING**

- Gymnasts receiving any award or medal must be in their club leotards or club tracksuits. Hair must be neat. No sock or shoes. If gymnast are not looking the same they will not be allowed on the podium or in the group.
- Parents will be given a change to take photographs of their children but in a decent manner.
- Please make sure that all coaches and gymnast knows this before the competition.
- This rule will be handled strict. With no exceptions.

#### <u>GROUPING</u>

- The competition will start on time, if gymnast are late they will not be moved to another section. Please make sure that all your gymnast are on time and at right place. Go through the program with them in your club.
- Grouping for warm-up and competing will be done by Marilyn Julies and Madeleine van der Merwe. But it's the coaches responsibility to make sure that the gymnasts are dressed correctly and ready for warm-up or competing. Marilyn and Madeleine will only assist in the management of the floor.
- NO late gymnast or coaches will be granted to move to other sections. Please make sure that all coaches understands this rule.
- It is the coaches responsibility to inform the parents to be 60 minutes prior their warmup at the competition. Please make sure that all the parents are aware of this.

# **COACHES**

- Coaches are responsible to bring their own copy of the program with them to the competition.
- Coaches must be dressed in their club clothing.
  Coaches must be on time and there throughout the competition. They need to take full
- responsibility for their club.
- To act at all times honestly, with integrity, and good sportsmanship, and in the best interest of the sport of Acrobatics Gymnastics.

#### **DISCIPLINE**

- Strict discipline will be handled throughout the competition.
- Coaches to behave towards all competitors, judges, coaches and officials in a respectful, courteous and polite way and to operate in accordance with Human Right, Child Protection Laws, and the FIG Code of Ethics.
- Judges to strictly observe the Technical Regulations, Code of Points, Judges Rules' and Judges' Oath. Failure to do so will results in a verbal warning from the President of the Superior Jury which may be through a CJP. In the case of a second offence at this competition or any subsequent competitions within the cycle, the judge will be sanctioned in accordance with the prevailing FIG Judges' Rules and Codes of Ethics and Discipline.
- Gymnasts and spectators to behave in a decent way, throughout the competition.

PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT ALL CLUBS/COACHES/JUDGES/PARENTS ARE AWARE OF THE ABOVE. TO AVOID ANY DISRUPTION OF THE COMPETITION. LET'S WORK AS A TEAM AND SUPPORT OUR GYMNASTS ON THIS BIG EVENT.
