Congratulations on being selected to represent your District at the 2017 South Zone Competition, to be held at the Western Cape Sport School, in Kuilsriver, Cape Town on 29 June 2017.

Competition attire for South Zone is Club leotard and Club tracksuit with a district badge and year badge

You are entitled to purchase the district badge (if you don't already have one) and the year badge, once you have paid and entered the South Zone competition. Neither of the badges is compulsory. You will have been recorded as receiving your district colours once you have competed at the South Zone Competition.

All orders and payments for badges must be placed with the club.

The District badge costs R60 and the Year badge R40.

Gymnasts qualifying today for the District team will need to advise their club by the latest **Thursday 18 May 2017**, whether they will be competing at the South Zone competition. Please note that the club might set an earlier date, in which case the earlier date is applicable. **Late entries will not be accepted.**

The final South Zone's entry fees will be communicated once we have received them. However, provisionally please budget as follows:

CATEGORY A: R520 (1st Event R400 + Officials cost of R 120) Plus, 2nd Event R 60

CATEGORY C: R250 (1st Event R200 + Officials cost of R 50) Plus, 2nd Event R 25

TUMBLING:

CATEGORY A: R520 (1st Event R400 + Officials cost of R 120) CATEGORY C: R250 (1st Event R200 + Officials cost of R 50)

Please note that because South Zone will be hosted in the Western Cape, the officials fee is payable for Trampoline and Tumbling if gymnasts compete in both. Kindly remember lines of communication are parent/gymnast -> Club - >Province. Please ensure all communication is directed to your club.
