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## WAG Selection Policy and Criteria

### JUDGES:

#### 1.) Point system

Judges will receive points every time that they judge at a competition. These points along with their qualification will make judge selection for away competitions a lot easier.

#### 2.) Rotation

Judges will be rotated at each competition giving every willing judge the opportunity to judge.

Judges will also be chosen accordingly with regards to club, district and provincial representation.

Obviously Level 1 judges will be given the opportunity to judge at the level 1 – 3 competitions in order to gain experience.

#### 3.) Qualification needed at each competition

In order for judges to be eligible to judge at competitions they need the following qualification:

##### LEVEL 1 – 3:

District Trials: level 1 or higher

South Zone Trials: level 1 or higher (preferably a qualification that will qualify you as a head judge)

##### LEVEL 4 – 6:

District trials: Level 2 or higher (level 1 judges for scribes)

Provincial trials: Level 2 or higher

Nationals: Level 2 or higher (preferably a qualification that will qualify you as a head judge)

##### LEVEL 7 –OLYMPIC:

A national qualification or higher is required to judge at these competitions (level 2 judges for scribes, time and line judges)

### COACHES:

#### 1) Point system:

Coaches will also be awarded points in order to make the selection of coaches easier. Coaches will be awarded points for the following:

- Their qualification
- The ranking of their gymnasts (if gymnasts are medal winners this is also taken into account)
- If the coach has attended squad training or not

**2) Qualification:**

Level 1 – 3 competitions require a Level 1 qualification or higher

Level 4 – 6 competitions require a level 2 qualification or higher

**3.) How many are needed:**

This can only be determined once the number of entries have come in. But allocating of coaches for competitions will be done fairly with all districts having representation.

**QUALIFICATION AT COMPETITIONS:**

The qualification scores that were decided by SAGF were:

Level 1 – 3: 7.80

Level 4 – 6: 7.80

These are different to SAGF's qualifying scores as they decided at the TC on the following:

Level 1 – 3: 7.50

Level 4 – 6: 7.80

We can change these qualifying scores for our own competitions but at nationals and South Zone we will have to fall in line with SAGF's scores. We decided to make the level 1- 3 score higher so that we do not have gymnasts that should not be qualifying at the competitions (gymnasts that are too weak to be at South Zone)
